Welcome Home

It's difficult to believe that in the spring edition of *Life Links* we were announcing the establishment of a maternity home, and only six months later, we're ready to welcome our first residents! We encourage you to go to our *Friends of Vida* website to read the incredible story.

The short version of the story is, in six short months, we completed the purchase of a former senior living facility for the God-ordained price of \$333,333.33; paid off the mortgage through our *333 Fundraising Campaign*; accomplished a \$300,000+ renovation with the help of over 3,000 volunteer hours and numerous in-kind gifts of professional labor and materials; and even raised 1/3 of

the funds needed to run our program for the first year. The blessings poured down upon this ministry have shown God's tremendous power and His great love for the women and children we will serve in our new housing program.

Trinity House is one of the many reasons we hope you continue to support Vida with your gifts of time, talent, and treasure. Successful and expanded programming means bigger fundraising goals for Vida. It is with great humility that we continue to reach out to you, our supporters, over and over again to ask for your financial help. We have not yet met our goal to break even on our unexpectedly bigger budget for 2023. We are grateful to have such a big Vida family to turn to for help. Together, we can build a community where every woman feels valued, every baby is cherished, and every family is strengthened by the bonds of faith and love. **♦**



Trinity House



We continue to believe that God has a bold vision, including maternity housing, for how this unified Christian ministry can play a critical role in transforming the culture in the Fox Valley. There has been an incredible outpouring of generosity and support from the community for the maternity home expansion. It is clear that no one wants pregnant women living in public parks, cars, staying in shelter programming not designed to meet their unique needs, or in toxic relationships because they have no one to turn to for help. We are all in agreement that loving Christian communities can do better than that!

The renovation of Trinity House this past summer was a true labor of love by our large and incredible community of supporters. Renovations are finally complete, including new HVAC and security systems, just in time to keep our mothers and babies safe and warm this winter. We can't thank our volunteers enough for the well over 3,000 hours devoted to making this house a home!

This fall, we turned our attention to what will be needed for the day-to-day operation of our program. We have completed writing our Resident Handbook and the numerous Policies and Procedures needed to deliver high quality, Christ-centered, residential programming. We've also been busy building new relationships with other organizations and programs in the community to support us in serving our residents. And finally, we purchased a minivan! This used vehicle came with mission-friendly



pricing and will be perfect for transporting residents to and from important meetings and appointments and maybe even to the hospital in the middle of the night to deliver their baby!

God has continued to call and equip new team members to serve. This team of amazing women will be ready when we welcome our first residents home starting the week of October 30! Please keep in mind that our interns are mission critical and will serve as live-in staff for a year of service. We are already recruiting 2024 interns who will start their year of service in the spring of 2024. We are counting on you to share this unique service opportunity with friends and family who may be interested.

And last, but definitely not least, this program will be made possible by the continuing generosity of this community. We still have many unmet material needs for the house. Medical Clinic

Our medical clinic's numbers are also on the rise. Our medical team works with patients daily to heal from past and present wounds, which negatively impact their mental well-being and reproductive health.

Our medical clinic helps patients, like Mary, a teenager, who was devastated by the news she tested positive for an STD and needed the support of a compassionate nurse to affirm her unchanging value. Or Molly, who shared her despair because she wanted to keep the beautiful child she saw in the ultrasound but was being pressured by her boyfriend to have an abortion. Or Beth, who chose the path of a chemical abortion, alone and unsupported in her home. She desperately wanted permission to mourn the loss of her baby.

These stories are representative of the hundreds of individuals who come to us each month for help in various stages of grief, trauma, and despair. We meet them where they are on their journey without judgment or condemnation.

The medical clinic has a lot of good news to share! Vida began offering sports physicals this past summer. The service was warmly welcomed by local students and their parents. Our two available clinic dates filled up immediately! Ann Priest, APNP, saw male and female students, ages 10-17, from several school districts. The new clinic offering was even shared on social media by the local health department. Vida continues to offer sports physical appointments throughout the school year, upon request. This is a great way to provide a needed health service and introduce Vida services to teens and their parents. We will definitely have additional dedicated clinic dates for next summer too!

Vida has an exciting new telebehavioral mental health service option through the Wisconsin Free & Charitable Clinics (WAFCC)! Many of the individuals we serve struggle with anxiety, depression, and significant life stressors. To promote healthy individuals and families, we have begun a process to refer patients in need of mental health care to providers at Open Arms Clinic. We will also continue to make referrals to local providers for in-person care and are exploring other exciting options to bring mental health services into our building.

Chip In For Life Recap

On Monday, September 18, Vida hosted its 8th annual Chip In For Life golf outing. We celebrate, with thanksgiving, its tremendous success on every front!

God blessed us with gorgeous, unseasonably warm weather, and we again maxed out golf registration with 145 golfers. This year, we added a new event, a wine tasting, to the afternoon and welcomed dozens of additional guests to enjoy wine, snacks, and good company while overlooking the beautiful golf course. This inaugural wine tasting event went extremely well and will continue to be an enjoyable addition to Chip In For Life for non-golfers!

This year's Chip In For Life also provided record-breaking fundraising, raising more than \$90,000 at the event, and additional sponsorship of approximately \$190,000.00!

Support Services



Vida is serving a record number of parents in our Support Services program. We don't know of any other program in the entire country that serves over 100 parents in one month, and we're now serving over 200!

She prayed an angry prayer to God in the clinic parking lot, daring Him to miraculously help her find a path forward. When she returned home to Appleton, she was referred to Vida for help. She realized in her orientation appointment that Vida was the answer to that parking lot prayer.
